Dr. Moffatt's primary role as Director of Pima County's economic development efforts includes the development of the 500 acre Aerospace Research Campus and surrounding infrastructure south of Raytheon and implementation of the County's Economic Development Plan. A key component of that plan is the development of the Sonoran Corridor between I-19 and I-10 to connect two major employment centers as well as extend rail service and access to critical utilities, improve freight movement, airport access, and reduce commute times in a region projected to contribute \$3.2 Billion dollars annually to the local economy when built out. These components are all integral parts of the County's regional master planning and vision for economic development that elevates the viability of the region south of Tucson International Airport.
